REASON: Your conviction of reckless driving in a member jurisdiction in Connecticut General Statute 14-111n.

DURATION: The duration of your suspension is 30 DAYS.

YOU MUST: Pay a restoration fee of \$175.00. Fees are paid online at www.ct.gov/dmv or by mailing a check or money order payable to "DMV" to the address at the top of this notice.

YOU MAY: You may request an administrative hearing contesting this action if you were not convicted or are not the person involved.

WARNING: You must not operate a motor vehicle after your license is suspended until it has been restored.

The police will be notified of your suspension. If you drive while your license is suspended, you will be subject to law enforcement action.

PLEASE NOTE: If you have any questions regarding this notification, write to the D.M.V. or call (860) 263-5720. When you are eligible for RESTORATION, please provide any necessary documents and payments at least 30 days prior to your eligibility date.
