YOU MAY:

You may request an administrative hearing contesting this action if you

were not convicted or are not the person involved.

WARNING:

You must not operate a motor vehicle after your license is suspended

until it has been restored.

The police will be notified of your suspension. If you drive while your license is suspended, you will be subject to law enforcement action.

PLEASE NOTE:

When you are eligible for RESTORATION, please provide any necessary documents and payments at least 30 days prior to your eligibility date.
